Hospital/ Emergency Room Visit

If you believe your symptoms may indicate a medical emergency, call 911 and request transportation to an emergency room for evaluation, *do not drive yourself*.

While we hope you never need to visit the Emergency Room, should the situation arise, please inform the Emergency Room physicians and staff that you are a CVAM patient (or have your family do so) and request to be seen by one of our doctors. This ensures that we, who are familiar with your heart history, can provide care during your hospital stay and facilitate a smooth transition for follow-up care at our office.
